The Board met in session at the Linn County Jean Oxley Public Service Center.

Present: Chairperson Walker and Vice Chairperson Rogers. Absent: Supervisor Oleson (personal business). Board members voting "AYE" unless otherwise noted.

Chairperson Walker called the meeting to order.

The Board heard updates from the following Elected Officials:

Brian Gardner, Sheriff - salary comparisons for new position will be forwarded to the Board once he receives the information from Lisa Powell; potential contract in the amount of \$45,000 to review the per diem rate for housing federal inmates at the jail.

Discussion continued regarding how a Deputy would be utilized as a security presence in the Public Service Center and incident response times.

Chairperson Walker asked about upcoming dates for implicit bias training as well as a request for Gardner to re-join the meetings for the law enforcement round table meetings.

Sharon Gonzalez, Treasurer - working with Darrin Gage on lettering and signage; will be attending training for the next three days.

Joel Miller, Auditor - Accounting Services: conducting training on new travel policy; W2's and 1099's due by 1/31/19; wellness program incentives to be paid in February. Real Estate: no new projects; valuation report done days/weeks earlier than before.
