

LINN COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
CEDAR RAPIDS, LINN COUNTY, IOWA
MONDAY, FEBRUARY 25, 2019 10:00 A.M.

The Board met in session at the Linn County Jean Oxley Public Service Center.
Present: Chairperson Walker, Vice Chairperson Rogers and Supervisor Oleson. Board members voting "AYE" unless otherwise noted.

Chairperson Walker called the meeting to order.

Motion by Rogers, seconded by Oleson to approve minutes of February 20, 2019 as printed.

Dawn Schott, Juvenile Detention Diversion Serv. Dir., presented the Prison Rape Elimination Act (PREA) Audit Services Agreement between Linn County and The Iowa Department of Human Rights (IDHR). The auditor will receive up to \$6,000 plus hotel, mileage and meal expenses (paid from surplus funds). The Board will approve on Wednesday.

Mike Kasper, Deputy Sheriff, presented the Fourth Amendment to the Lease Agreement for a radio tower that is part of the Linn County radio system. All leases are paid through the E911 Board and this will streamline the sites under the Sheriff's Office. The Board will approve on Wednesday.

Darrin Gage, Dir. of Policy & Admin., presented two change orders for the O'Brien Building remodel project as follows: CO #1 - \$685.00 (builders risk insurance missed in the RFP) and CO #2 - \$15,600 (concrete % masonry work on exterior; added stoop and conduit; and concrete changes to the wash bay).
